**President's Report:**

Rianne to ask about PRRD's interest in administering Gazebo facility.

**Fundraising Report:**

An application for \$22,000 for repairs and improvements grant from gaming went to Regional District from Rianne. If granted, work needs to be completed within the year.

**Facilities, Grounds, and Maintenance Report:**

Dave Scherger moved heathers donated by John Keays to Community Centre and donated his equipment and time. LCS paid \$150. for gas. Volunteers helped to plant them on the slope in front of the Centre.

Lee has done a great job on grounds keeping at the Centre and Gazebo. A community work day may be in order to plan for a May spruce-up job.

Rianne reports an odor at the Centre and will follow up on any possible sewer problems. She will follow up with RD.

**Goodwill:**

No cards were sent recently. Only births and memorials will be printed in the Barnacle. Stone work for Don Worthen Memorial is ongoing. Mary Ann will purchase bulbs at \$50. to plant around the tree and benchwork as completed.

**Barnacle:**

Deadline is this week and Ann needs articles. Printing cost is \$6.00 each and Rianne will look into funding for future printing. Steve will ask Ann if she would like to write as a paid reporter for the Barnacle at \$250. per issue.

**Library:**

Amanda did some more shelving and is planning on moving all books from adjacent room into the Library with volunteers.

**Playgroup:**

The fun has started up again and will take place in the room next to the Library Fridays from 10 am to noon. Coordination is being done by Jasmin Marshman. It is planned that the Orca Bus will come to Lund two days a week. Jurgen has volunteered to organize play structure building materials and plans. Percy Redford and Russ Morrison are donating lumber. Two work parties will be planned in January and March for work and assembly.

A petition letter has been circulated by Ann Snow asking Transportation Dept to modify existing speed limits and signage on the Highway near the Centre and on Finn Bay Rd. approaching the Highway. Residents may send these letters of support to the Transportation Office in Powell River.

LCS received noise complaints regarding events at the Gazebo. Colleen and Rianne will follow up to clarify dates and nature of problems.
